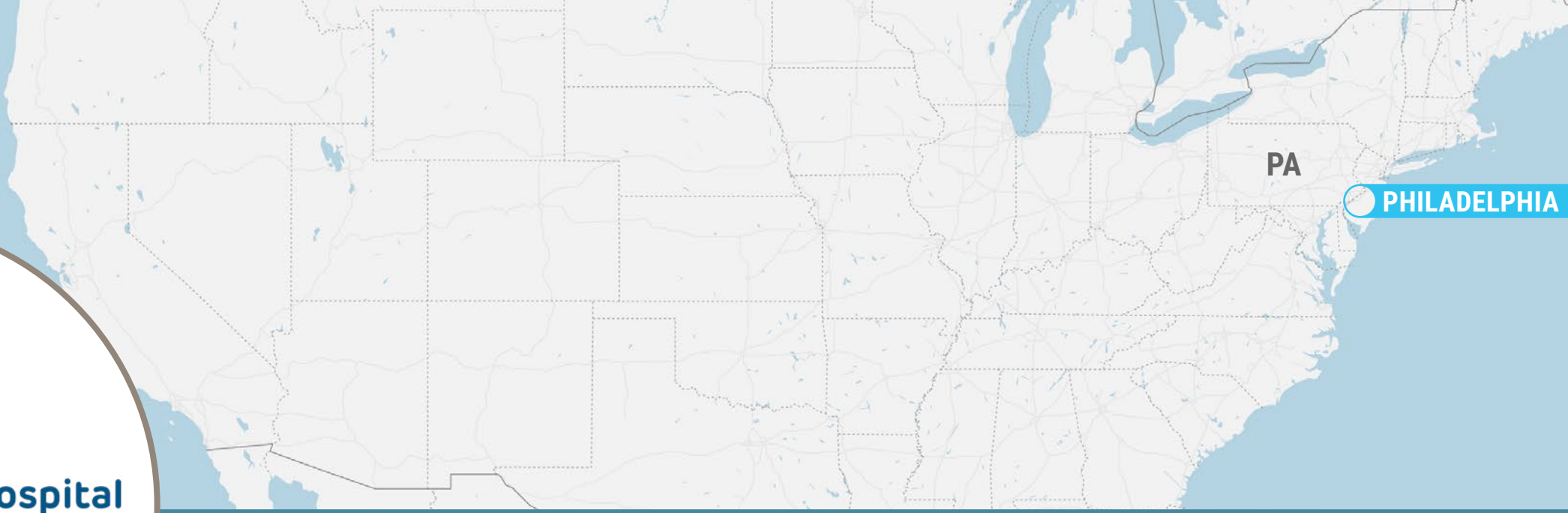

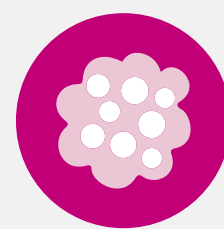
## U.S.-U.A.E. PARTNERSHIPS
