

OVERVIEW

UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center) is taking health care from where it is to where it needs to be by creating a future built on ideas, innovation, and patient care. They are steadfastly committed to providing premier health care to patients in the U.S. and around the world.

A \$26 billion health care provider and insurer based in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania (U.S.), UPMC is inventing new models of patient-centered, cost-effective, accountable care. With locations around the world, their nearly 100,000 employees are committed to providing outstanding patient care as close to home as possible. In the U.S., they own and operate 40 hospitals (Pennsylvania, New York, and Maryland), 800 doctors' offices and outpatient sites, and an Insurance Services Division of more than 4.5 million-members. Internationally, they have locations in Ireland and Italy and a consulting presence in Kazakhstan.

Working in close collaboration with the University of Pittsburgh (Pitt) Schools of the Health Sciences, UPMC is an integrated health care system with renowned centers of excellence in transplantation, cancer, heart and vascular, neurology and neurosurgery, ophthalmology, orthopaedics, sports medicine and concussion, pediatrics, psychiatry, rehabilitation, and women's health, among others. They also work closely with Pitt on breakthrough research; the school is among the top 10 in the U.S. to receive research funding from the National Institutes of Health.

- ISMETT, Palermo Since 1997, this facility is known across Europe and the Middle East as a transplant center of excellence and a reference hospital for the entire Mediterranean area. ISMETT provides patients with the most advanced therapies for end-stage organ failure in addition to advanced care interventions across a variety of specialties including heart and vascular as well as cancer.

UPMC has been providing high-quality health care in Ireland since 2006. UPMC hospitals include UPMC Whitfield Hospital in Waterford, UPMC Aut Even Hospital in Kilkenny, and UPMC Kildare Hospital in Clane. UPMC Hillman Cancer Centers, located in Waterford and Cork, offer a range of medical and surgical oncology treatments and advanced radiotherapies. Additional locations include UPMC Sports Medicine Clinics in Waterford, Limerick, and Tipperary and a country-wide UPMC Concussion Network. Other facilities include an outpatient clinic in Carlow and an Institute for Health at the Connacht Dome in County Mayo.

In March 2023, UPMC acquired the renowned Sports Surgery Clinic (SSC), a leading independent hospital located in Dublin. Well-known for its care of patients and athletes across Ireland and Europe, the SSC is now part of UPMC's network of orthopaedic, sports medicine, and rehabilitation facilities, and is also UPMC's fourth hospital in Ireland.

NEUROLOGICAL INSTITUTE

UPMC is home to the largest academic neurosurgery department in the U.S. With national and international recognition for minimally invasive neurosurgery and stroke research and treatment, experts at UPMC are innovators in treating complex, life-threatening conditions of the brain and spine. They care for the sickest patients, many of whom who have been turned away by other facilities.



HEART AND VASCULAR INSTITUTE

The UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute is one of the world's premier centers for comprehensive cardiovascular care. Through collaboration and teamwork, they are developing revolutionary medical devices and new models for treatment that improve the lives of people facing even the most complex heart and vascular conditions from congenital heart disease to heart failure. UPMC has made significant contributions to the advancement of cardiovascular medicine. For example, UPMC is among the few hospitals nationwide to have performed more than 1,400 adult cardiac transplants and 1,600 adult lung or heart-lung transplants – making it one of the most experienced in the world. Additionally, their artificial heart program – one of the nation's oldest and most active – has treated more than 1,200 people over the past 20 years with mechanical circulatory support devices.

KAZAKHSTAN

UPMC's clinical and operational experts are helping Nazarbayev University transform its affiliated University Medical Center into Kazakhstan's first fully integrated academic medical center, adapting UPMC's successful model in Pittsburgh.

CROATIA

In 2022, UPMC announced a partnership to establish a UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Zabok, Croatia. The agreement will provide access to cuttingedge cancer therapies to patients in Croatia and neighboring countries. It is expected to open in 2025 and will be managed by UPMC.

TRANSPLANT SERVICES

UPMC is a pioneer in organ transplantation and continues to innovate in this field. Their program was founded in 1981 by the late Thomas E. Starzl, MD, PhD, whose foresight, perseverance, and commitment made him the modern-day father of organ transplantation. They routinely care for the sickest patients. The USPC Transplant Services specializes in liver, kidney, pancreas, small bowel, liver/small bowel, heart, heart/lung, double-lung, single-lung, and multiple-organ transplants. They are also a leader in livingdonor liver transplantation. Their ISMETT facility in Palermo, Italy, is a highly regarded transplant center throughout the Mediterranean.

VISION INSTITUTE

A recognized leader in the diagnosis and treatment of eye diseases and disorders, the mission of the UPMC Vision Institute is to improve patients' quality of life through vision preservation and restoration. Under the leadership of José-Alain Sahel, MD, one of the world's top experts in retinal diseases and vision restoration, UPMC provides groundbreaking research to find new ways to prevent, diagnose, and treat eye disorders and diseases as well as to preserve healthy vision. Dr. Sahel is an exceptional class professor of Ophthalmology at Sorbonne Université and was the founding director of The Vision Institute (Sorbonne Université, Inserm, CNRS) Paris, France. The UPMC Vision Institute opened in Pittsburgh in April of 2023, and is a leading center focused on the cornea, retina, optic nerve, glaucoma, neuro-ophthalmology, and orbital disorders.



ORTHOPAEDIC CARE AND SPORTS MEDICINE

UPMC's world-renowned sports medicine program was founded by Freddie Fu, MD, one of the most recognized and beloved physicians in the world and a global leader in many clinical advancements in sports medicine and orthopaedic care. An established leader in advanced orthopaedic care, UPMC provides services to address the full spectrum of musculoskeletal injuries and conditions and is a leading center for research and clinical trials, allowing their experts to deliver the latest treatments. Volker Musahl, MD, orthopaedic surgeon and medical director of UPMC International Sports Medicine has traveled to UPMC Salvator Mundi International Hospital in Italy to care for many elite European athletes.





CONCUSSION PROGRAM

The UPMC Sports Medicine Concussion Program, led by international expert Michael "Micky" Collins PhD, was the first of its kind when launched in 2000. Since then, UPMC's program has become a global leader in sports-related concussion including testing, diagnosis, treatment, and research. With over 20,000 patient visits each year, their skilled team of clinicians treats high school, college, and professional athletes from across the U.S. and around the world. UPMC provides the same level of expert care to people of all ages who sustain concussions during routine activities.

UPMC HILLMAN CANCER CENTER

With multiple locations in Ireland and Italy and more than 70 locations in the U.S., UPMC Hillman Cancer Center offers cuttingedge treatment options and access to more than 570 clinical trials. Additionally, they are one of only 53 National Cancer Institutedesignated Comprehensive Cancer Centers in the U.S., an elite group recognized for their demonstrated excellence in cancer research, patient care, education, and community outreach.

ORGAN TRANSPLANTATION

UPMC Children's established the first pediatric transplant program in the U.S., the Hillman Center for Pediatric Transplantation. Since the program's inception in 1981, the hospital has performed more pediatric transplants than any other center and has discovered new treatment methods to improve long-term survival and quality of life for pediatric transplant recipients. World-renowned transplant surgeon George Mazariegos, MD, leads this service.


