



OVERVIEW

Mass General Brigham, headquartered in Boston, Massachusetts, USA, is an integrated academic health care system founded by Massachusetts General Hospital and Brigham and Women's Hospital. They deliver excellence across the full spectrum of health care, providing outstanding, world-class care and services from their prestigious academic medical centers and specialty hospitals to their acute-care community hospitals and home care programs.

Mass General Brigham's five Harvard-affiliated research and teaching hospitals are consistently ranked among the best hospitals in the United States and globally. Thousands of their physicians are Harvard Medical School faculty, teaching the next generation of health care leaders. The integrated health care system ensures patients have easy access to highly specialized physicians in almost every medical field.

Their commitment to excellence transcends borders, welcoming patients from around the world to their facilities in the heart of Boston. Each year, thousands of patients from more than 120 countries travel to these hospitals to experience internationally recognized expertise in cancer, neurology, cardiology, orthopedics, pediatrics, and other specialties. Mass General Brigham has also collaborated with organizations in more than 40 countries to advance standards of care and enhance the health of communities worldwide.



At Mass General Brigham, cancer patients benefit from world-class, research-driven clinical care.

- a. One of the world's first centers to use proton beam therapy to treat cancer and the first in the United States to house two proton beam units. Since 2001, the cancer team has treated nearly 13,000 adult and pediatric patients with personalized proton therapy plans.
- b. One of the world's foremost providers of cellular and gene immunotherapies (including CAR T-cell therapy, tumor-infiltrating lymphocytes, etc.) for cancer patients. These treatments, which remain rare worldwide, can induce longterm responses for a number of cancers with a single dose.
- c. Their clinicians use multi-cancer early detection tests to potentially find multiple types of cancer from a single blood sample-before symptoms even

The Mass General Brigham orthopedics team treats conditions and injuries of all types - from the most common to complex orthopedic patients. They are developing and offering advanced orthopedic surgeries, treatments and care, always with a focus on alleviating pain and restoring function. They provide comprehensive medical care for the full range of orthopedic, spine and sports medicine needs.

Mass General Brigham has been a leader in cardiology for more than a century. From conducting the first mitral valve surgery and pioneering the development of pacemakers, to launching the first cardiac care unit and advancing minimally invasive surgical techniques. Today they continue to push the cardiology field forward through innovative research, clinical trials and patient care. The system-home to some of the world's foremost authorities in diagnosing, treating and preventing heart diseaseincludes specialists in cardiovascular medicine, cardiac surgery, vascular surgery and more.

Their multidisciplinary teams regularly treat international patients for conditions including:

- Congenital disorders in need of advanced fetal care and newborn medicine
- Cystic fibrosis
- Epilepsy
- Infectious disease and immunodeficiencies

Meanwhile, Mass General Brigham's pediatric surgical teams are international experts in treating common and rare conditions including:
